



EnRiMa with a dedicated session at the III Congreso ESES in Bilbao

EnRiMa project will be presented in a dedicated workshop "Smart tools catalogue for the energy management in buildings" that will take place as a side event of a larger conference, the third edition of Congreso ESES, taking place in Bilbao, Spain on 1 and 2 October 2013. The conference is dedicated to the energy services market, and is organised by three Spanish multipliers active in the energy efficiency and energy services markets (AMI, ANESE and A3e) and other energy sector stakeholders. For this edition, the Basque Government and the Basque Regional Energy Agency (EVE) supported the event's organisation.

The Workshop is a joint diffusion event between EnRiMa, Wattalyst and CONCERTO PIME's projects and it will introduce some new applications related to energy efficiency in buildings, specifically in air conditioning systems, which have been developed by Tecnalia, partner of the EnRiMa project.

Each of these initiatives has developed tools that are focused on energy management of buildings, demand forecast, economic dispatching of CHP and user comfort in buildings. Whenever possible, the tools will be showcased in demonstration mode, offering a glance at the input/output variables and at the benefits that each tool can provide to the user.

EnRiMa will be presented by Emilio López Cano (Universidad Rey Juan Carlos) and D. Eugenio Perea (Tecnalia) within the session dedicated to the planning and operational model of the energy systems in buildings. Speakers will showcase the functionalities of the EnRiMa DSS system, as one of the smart tools for the energy management in buildings.

The workshop aims to stress the importance of an efficient building energy management, which is based on programming operations through a series of hardware and software tools that are called "Building Energy Management System".

EnRiMa (Energy Efficiency and Risk Management in Public Buildings) is a project funded by the European Commission under the 7th Framework Programme (FP7), launched on the 1st October 2010 that will run until April 2014. The project aims at developing a decision-support system (DSS) that allows operators to control energy flows in energy-efficient buildings and areas of public use, and which will be customised for the target stakeholders to enable its commercialisation.
