



## EnRiMa contributes to the discussion at the event “European projects on energy efficiency in buildings”

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2013, HC ENERGÍA, partner in the EnRiMa consortium, participates in the FAEN event dedicated to “**European projects on energy efficiency in buildings**”, which takes place at the Auditorium Príncipe Felipe in Oviedo, Spain. Luis Manuel Santos Moro, representing EnRiMa, will deliver a brief overview of the project, including some more details concerning the project approach to the energy efficiency issues.

Successively, Eugenio Perea Olabarria, from Tecnalía, will follow with a more technical presentation, together with his colleague Emilio López Cano, researcher at the department of Statistics and Operative Research, for the Rey Juan Carlos University.

Other EU funded projects will join the discussion, sharing their best practices on energy efficiency issues: AUTONOMOUS OFFICE, WATTALYST and ENERSIP projects. Two round tables will follow giving the audience opportunity to interact with the speakers and provide direct feedback on their current results.

The day will close with the presentation of the results come out from the round tables and with a speech by Mr Isaac Pola Alonso, the Director of Mining and Energy at the Ministry of Economy and Employment of The Asturias Region.

The Symposium will be a good chance for the EnRiMa project to join the discussion around issues related to energy efficiency and environmental sustainability, to share best practices with other EU funded projects and to enlarge its network.

Established on on 16th July, 2001, FAEN (the Asturian Energy Foundation) is the Regional Energy Agency of the Principado of Asturias (Spain). It works on different activities related with energy as studies, energy planning, diffusion, audits, training, counselling and adviser, technological energy research and financial aid on energy projects.

EnRiMa (Energy Efficiency and Risk Management in Public Buildings) is a project funded by the European Commission under the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme (FP7), launched on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010 that will run until April 2014. The project aims at developing a decision-support system (DSS) that allows operators to control energy flows in energy-efficient buildings and areas of public use, and which will be customised for the target stakeholders to enable its commercialisation.

The EnRiMa consortium, led by the University of Stockholm, includes nine institutions from six European countries: University College London (UK), International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis - IIASA (Austria), Universidad Rey Juan Carlos (Spain), Centre for Energy and Innovative Technologies - CET (Austria), Minerva Consulting and Communication (Belgium), SINTEF Group (Norway), Tecnalia Research and Innovation (Spain), and Hidrocantábrico Energía (Spain).
